We spoke with Dan and he said it would be helpful if you looked at the 2008 models on the National website and had a specific unit and color in mind. They want to sell these within the next month so don't delay if you're interested. The last units were finished and shipped out to Arizona on Feb. 1st and are in Quartzsite and Phoenix.

This has been verified by the FBI (their link is also included below). Please pass this on to everyone in your email address book. It is spreading fast so be prepared should you get this call. Most of us take those summons for jury duty seriously a new and ominous kind of fraud has surfaced. The caller claims to be a jury coordinator. If you protest that you never received a

summons for jury duty, the scammer asks you for your Social Security number and date of birth so he or she can verify the information and cancel the arrest warrant.

Give out any of this information and bingo, your identity was just stolen. The fraud has been reported so far in 11 states, including New York, Oklahoma, Florida, Illinois, Texas and Colorado.

This (swindle) is particularly insidious because they use intimidation over the phone to try to bully people into giving information by pretending they are with the court system. The FBI and the Federal Court System have issued nationwide alerts on their web sites, warning consumers about the fraud.
